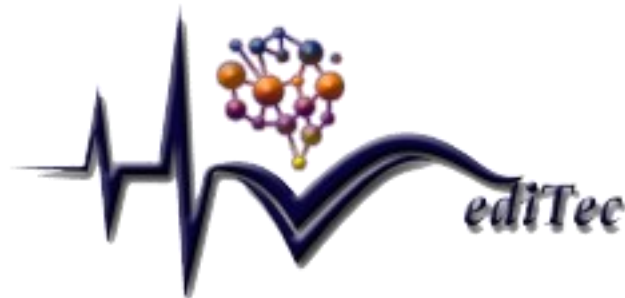

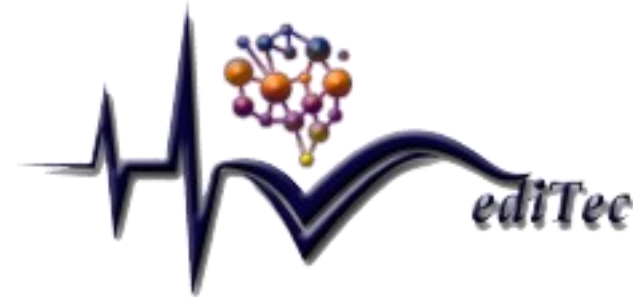

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## TRAINING FOR MEDICAL EDUCATION VIA INNOVATIVE TECHNOLOGY IN BRNO

MediTec Scientific Program in Brno, Czech Republic was organized by Masaryk University and financially supported by European Erasmus plus Project, during the period of 8th to 19th of July 2019. Eight Iraqi and four Iranian students from schools of Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry and six Jordanian students from school of Computer Sciences participated in this course. The aim of the project was training the students about application of Computer-based simulation systems in medical education.

Also, the project included medical ethics and medical office management classes and laboratory of physiology and medical physics.

There was also computer-based simulation training in emergency medicine.

At the end of the course all the students received attendance certificates from Masaryk University.



## OPENING CEREMONY OF MEDITEC SIMULATION CENTER IN IUMS (MEDITEC EXCELLENCE LAB)

The MediTec Simulation Center was established in IUMS, Faculty of Medicine, Skill Laboratory Sciences on 17 September 2019 with the presence of IUMS Chancellor, Meditec Coordinator of IUMS.

The MediTec project was launched

in 2017 in partnership with universities and institutes from Iran, Germany, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Malta, Jordan and Iraq and with the financial backing of the European Union with the aim of enhancing the scientific and practical skills of medical professors and students in using Innovative equipment and simulated models.
