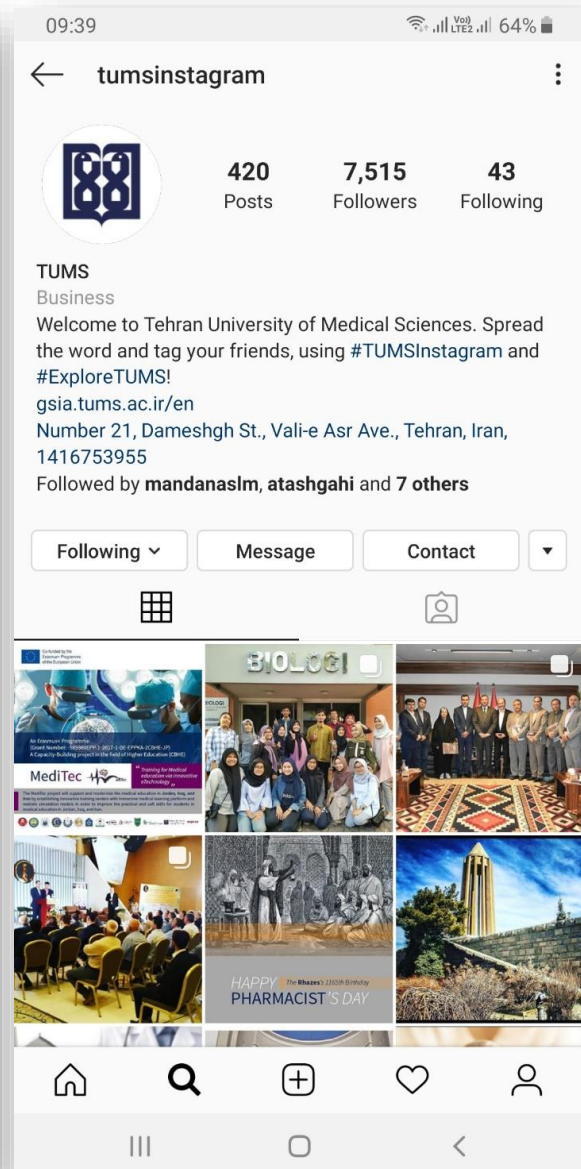




## Social Media and events
