To Summarized:

the first 10 questions were asked in 5 Likert scale formats ranging from 1 poor to 5 very good and result of these question whereas follow

The response indicated that

Most participant stated that all the topics being covered, a special interest in more practical sessions especially in field of surgery and ophthalmology, forensic medicine. Since most of participant were from school of medicine in most of universities, dental medicine and experimental medicine although found interested by most, few mentions that could be replaced by other topics
