### ***The MediTec Project***

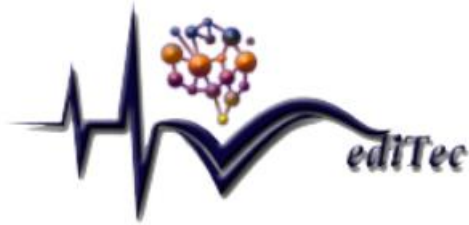
